R-1234yf Charging Hose

1. Turn actuator valve handle clockwise until it stops to retract the inner stem.
2. Attach valve assembly and hose to the top of the R-1234yf refrigerant can (left hand thread).
3. Hold back the sliding ring of the quick coupler while pushing connector onto vehicle's A/C LOW SIDE service port.
4. Start the vehicle's engine. Turn A/C to MAX COOL and fan switch to high.
5. Turn actuator valve handle counterclockwise until it stops. Allow refrigerant to enter the vehicle's A/C system.
6. While charging, rotate can between 12 o'clock and 3 o'clock, continually agitating (sweeping) can back and forth. Continue until the can is empty, usually 5-7 minutes, or until the correct amount of charge is reached. **DO NOT OVERCHARGE THE SYSTEM.**
7. When the correct amount of charge is reached, turn actuator handle clockwise until it stops.
8. Pull sliding ring up on the quick coupler and remove it from port.
9. If the R-1234yf can is empty, remove it from the charging hose and discard. Save and reuse the charging hose for future use.

CAUTION: Always wear hand and eye protection when servicing a vehicle's A/C system
